

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE Chinese vase sells for £810,000, breaking all house records



Fellows inaugural Antiques, Silver & Collectables auction defied all expectations when lot 136 sold for £810,000. The large and impressive Chinese porcelain wucai fish vase was entered to sale with an auction estimate of £1,200 - 1,800.

Intricately decorated with small golden carp, lotus blossoms and undulating grasses the wucai vase's enamelling and painted decoration presented a beautiful piece.

The vase sparked a fierce bidding war from interested parties on the internet, on the telephone and in the room. It went on to completely surpass all expectations, selling for £810,000 (plus buyer's premium 20% / 10% + VAT), breaking all house records.
